<p>AUSTRALIA DAY</p>	<p>DIWALI</p>	<p>1 National holiday where people gather with family and friends to give thanks. Traditionally includes a turkey dinner.</p>	<p>5 National holiday commemorating the arrival of the First Fleet in 1788. Celebrated with outdoor events and fireworks.</p>
<p>INDEPENDENCE DAY</p>	<p>ST. PATRICK'S DAY</p>	<p>2 Religious holiday celebrating the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Often involves egg hunts and special meals.</p>	<p>6 Cultural holiday celebrating Irish culture and the patron saint of Ireland. Often marked by wearing green and parades.</p>
<p>THANKSGIVING</p>	<p>ANZAC DAY</p>	<p>3 Religious holiday of lights in India. People celebrate with lamps, fireworks, and sweets.</p>	<p>7 National holiday in Australia and New Zealand to remember soldiers who served. Includes dawn services and marches.</p>
<p>HANUKKAH</p>	<p>EASTER</p>	<p>4 National holiday celebrated with fireworks and parades. People honor their country's history.</p>	<p>8 Religious holiday celebrated by Jewish communities. It lasts 8 days. It commemorates the miracle of the oil.</p>
