1. It marks the beginning of the fight for freedom from Spanish rule, initiated by Miguel Hidalgo y Costilla.
 2. The Mexican army, led by General Ignacio Zaragoza, defeated the French forces at this battle on May 5, 1862.
 3. Benito Juárez, as President of Mexico, enacted a series of liberal reforms that sought to modernize the country and reduce the power of the Church.
 4. On March 18, 1938, the President of Mexico, implemented a major economic reform by taking control of the oil resources.
 5. The last Aztec emperor led the resistance against the Spanish conquerors until his capture in 1521.
 6. This war, from 1846 to 1848, resulted in Mexico ceding a significant portion of its northern territory to the United States and saw the sacrifice of many Mexican soldiers.
 7. On September 27, 1821, the Army of the Three Guarantees entered Mexico City, marking the end of Spanish rule.
 8. He was a leader in the fight for independence who was later betrayed and executed in 1831.
 9. He was a prominent revolutionary, led numerous campaigns against the federal government during the Mexican Revolution.
 10. It was promulgated in 1917, established social rights and aimed to address issues that sparked the Mexican Revolution.
