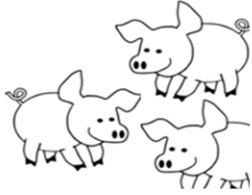


Three little pigs tale - Reading activities

They built their houses very quickly and then sang and danced all day because they were lazy. The third little pig worked hard all day and built his house with bricks.

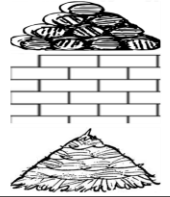
I. Answer the question:
