




World War II X

World War II, also known as the Second World War, was a global war that lasted from 1939 to 1945. It involved most of the world's countries—including all of the great powers—eventually forming two opposing military alliances: the Allies and the Axis. It was the most widespread war in history; it directly involved more than 100 million people from over 30 countries. In a state of total war, the major participants threw their entire economic, industrial, and military resources into the war effort, unlike any other war before it.

World War II was the deadliest conflict in human history, marked by 50 to 85 million fatalities. Most deaths were from starvation and Soviet Union and China. It included massacres, genocide, the holocaust, biological warfare, poison gas, nuclear bombing, saturation, disease, and the first use of nuclear weapons in history.

The Axis advance halted in 1942 when Japan lost the Battle of Guadalcanal. The Allies then defeated the Germans in North Africa and then, decisively, at El Alamein. In 1944, they defeated the Germans in France and Germany, and then, in 1945, the last of the German forces on the Eastern Front. The Allied invasion of Sicily and the final invasion of Italy, which took place in 1943, preceded the Allied invasion of Normandy in 1944. In 1945, the Allies fought the Japanese in the Pacific, the Axis lost the initiative and undertook a scorched earth policy. In 1945, the Allies invaded Germany and its allies. During 1945, the Japanese suffered major reverses in the Pacific, including the atomic bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki, while the Allies crippled the Japanese Navy and captured key Western Pacific islands.
